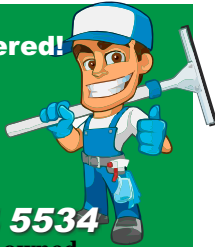

Drying winds are the last thing fresh Spring growth needs, but they arrived last week so we had to deal with it. Soak hoses are the way to get moisture down into deep - wind and evaporation zaps the ground and gardeners as well I am sure. I have been leaving the majority

of the watering until late in the day. Keep water up to Maples and shallow rooted shrubs like Rhododendron, Camellia and Azaleas. Newly planted tall trees move down to the roots in wind if they are not secured to stakes. A couple of large rocks around the base will add weight if bare rooted trees have just been planted.

The pretty froth is now gone from early **Flowering Cherries**, as new leaves take the place of blossom and thankfully it continues with the lovely white Mount Fuji then Kan Zan with bright pink blossom bursting and lastly Shimidsu Sakura - so beautiful...

Hydrangeas and Roses should be well leafed up now, so need watered daily during strong winds. When leaves are firmer, they handle the elements without this attention.

Bedding plants: Many on offer now to plant for Summer colour in gardens, pots and hanging baskets. All bedding plants once planted, need attention - water and folia feeding.

I have been sifting soil for re-sowing patches in the lawn and decided to use sifted soil as a top layer before planting annuals and seeds. Sifted soil packs round new roots firmly so they don't dry, enabling roots to grow quickly. Soil, is after all nature given for growing and here long before we had so many other growing medium choices! BUT planting comes to a stand still on windy days - don't be tempted to plant out anything until the ground can hold moisture. Plants will last in pots and punnets until the time is right...

Plants for the right place - starting with dry areas of the garden - under hungry trees or areas that drain too readily. You will be wasting your time and money planting shallow rooted plants like Rhododendrons, Azaleas, Camellias, Hydrangeas, Roses or Hellebores in these areas, unless you are prepared to mulch and water often. It's best to group with plants that will work their roots down to look for moisture like: Euphorbias in all their varieties, colours and sizes, Agapanthus: large and small varieties - they are great on a slope. Buddleias will fill gaps at the back of a border, lovely sliver blue foliage and blue to cerise/ purple flowers, must be cut back well after flowering to keep bushy, also a great food source for butterflies.

Grasses always look good grouped together as they are in nature - they do well in the dry and add movement to the garden. Geraniums also require little attention in a dry spot once established - but do need water until established. Lupins: Are wonderful in big groups - they also need water until they become established. After the first flowering they will self seed to make their groups larger. All these plants once established will cope with dry conditions.

Damp, Shade loving plants to consider are Hydrangea, Hostas, Heuchera - Not all shade loving plants have to be green. Heuchera plants come in a delightful variety of colors. Plant these as borders around the base of trees, or even along the edge of walkways! Acanthus Mollis Aluminum plant: (Ground cover) Hellebores (Winter Rose) - a must for every shade garden.

Vegetable garden: Keep moulding up potatoes as they show leaf - this keeps them cooler, allowing more depth for them to grow a bigger crop.

I have sown mixed Lettuce seeds in a tray and plan to transplant them into the garden as I need them. Lettuce seedlings will hold in a tray for a long time in a shady spot and only really start growing when they are fed and watered in a sunny spot. Soil is a perfect temperature for veg growing - every seed planted will germinate and do well....*Cheers Linda.*

Oamaru water supply

Customers asked to be mindful of water use over next few weeks. Waitaki District Council is asking Oamaru water supply customers, including those south to Moeraki, to be mindful of their water use over the next few weeks while work is underway to increase treatment capacity at the Oamaru Water Treatment Plant.

The work is part of an exciting larger project to significantly improve the supply's resilience to adverse weather events and increased demand in the future, and is planned to include the installation of an additional 8,700m³ treated water reservoir at the treatment plant site during 2020. Council's Water Services and Waste Manager, Martin Pacey, said work on upgrading the treatment membranes has been ongoing throughout the year and will culminate with the installation of four new membrane racks over the next few weeks.

"We're heading into the summer period when water use traditionally ramps up with the warmer days, so it's something we need to consider and prepare people for now. Depending on how things go, there is a possibility we'll need to issue a conserve or restrict water notice while the membranes are being installed. However, we're hoping to avoid this if possible by encouraging the community to get behind this important upgrade and to reduce their water use now so we can keep our water reservoir topped up". Mr Pacey said Council is also encouraging the community to be conscious of water use at all other times with consideration to its value as a resource, the cost of treatment and sustainability. Some ways to reduce water use include:

- Making sure any leaks are fixed - including running toilets, dripping taps and leaking pipes
- (something Council is working on too)
- Hand-watering your garden, if possible, and not leaving hoses or sprinklers running overnight
- Taking a shorter shower, or taking a shower instead of a bath
- Turning the tap off when brushing your teeth
- Delaying washing your car for a few weeks, if you can
- Waiting until the dishwasher or washing machine is full before running a load

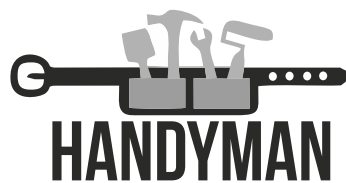

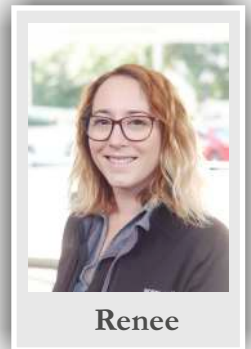
Let's talk About the New Season

Roller blinds are a sleek,

This is true especially in modern homes which have huge windows and very little wall space for drawing back drapes. They are available in a wide variety of fabrics which can screen, filter or block out the light.

Sunscreen blinds allow you to see out of the window during the day whilst the woven mesh fabric is designed to block UV rays and control solar energy, effectively reducing the amount of glare or heat transmitted into your home through the windows. They will prevent your soft furnishings from fading while offering a degree of daytime privacy from your neighbours or street traffic - so long as there is enough light on the outside of your home. At night with your lights on they will operate in reverse so beware that you will lose your privacy.

If you require both day and night-time privacy there is an option to install a twin bracket which offers the ability to have both a sunscreen blind and a blockout blind in the same window. These blinds operate independently.

Roller blinds are easily fitted onto the architraves of almost all windows and when they are not required they roll up to be most unobtrusive.

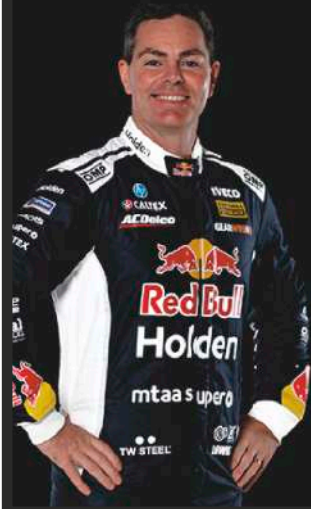

Ginger Beer

To make bug, In a jar or jug place, 1 tsp dried yeast, 2 tsp dried ginger, 4 tsp sugar, 600mls cold water, Stir and leave at room temperature

Each day for 7 days feed with:

2 tsp dried ginger, 4 tsp sugar, Stir.

To make ginger beer

Place 1kg sugar in large pot, Add 1200mls boiling water and let sugar dissolve. Add the juice of 4 lemons, Strain the contents of the ginger beer bug through cloth and add juice to pot. Add 7 litres of room temperature water. Stir and then fill clean dry plastic bottles 7/8ths full. Squeeze air out of the bottles to stop them exploding. Screw cap on tightly. Store at room temperature and leave to brew for 3-4 weeks.

To keep it going

Divide remainder of bud in 1/2, Give away 1 half. Place remainder in clean jar with 600mls cold water and continue to feed 4 tsp sugar and 2 tsp ginger for a week.
