Gardening has not been cancelled... on a positive note, weeding, raking and planting is full on - so be safe staying home at this difficult time and spend time with nature - rewards are real.

Leaves are turning and some beginning to fall, Silver Birch in our garden is always the first, along with our wonderfully prolific flowering Bougainvillea dropping a crimson carpet.

Cutting back has stepped up here, in readiness for a layer of compost, then pea straw as a final cover, when most of the leaves have been removed later on.

Now is a good time to repot pots and baskets that have been flowering and filling containers with roots. At this time of the year, everything planted will settle in well and put on growth before the colder months slow growth down. It is best to pull all out to see how root bound a pot or basket is, then usually a spade is needed to chop through two thirds of the root ball. Soak potted Shrubs with roots reduced, in a bucket of water until bubbles stop before replanting into new mix.

I water plants in at this time of the year with Comfrey tea. Brew a fertiliser with more potash and nitrogen than commercial feeds and Comfrey leaves are plentiful right now for picking and making plant tea. Comfrey as a Fertilizer has three major nutrients plus high levels of calcium, applied as a liquid soil drench or as a foliar spray. Making Comfrey tea: A generous bundle of Comfrey leaves, A bucket of water. Place chopped Comfrey leaves at the bottom of a bucket. Weigh down with a brick, fill bucket with water, and cover for three weeks before diluting - one part 'tea' to 10 parts water. If you would like a root of Comfrey, let the Ladies at the Garden corner at our Resource Recovery park know.

Keep dead - heading Roses in the hope of more blooms to make a last vibrant show, before they will be left to harden for Winter. Rust is always a problem on Roses in Autumn. Try to eradicate affected leaves from the bushes, as well as those on the ground and burn them to reduce this problem for next year. Don't feed Roses now - soft growth needs to make a start at hardening.

Lawns. As days become cooler and heavy dews are happening again, grass will start to recover from dryness and if lawns have no spring in them, there will probably be a high content of clay restricting roots. Gypsum applied before a good shower of rain, will help and if applied at intervals over a couple of years, there will be a spring in your lawn.

Fruit: Late Peaches, Quince and Apple trees are dripping with fruit. If you need to store a small amount of Apples, the refrigerator is a good option. Place them in the crisper drawer in a plastic bag with holes, or cover the Apples with a damp paper towel. Keep boxes of Apples in a cool, dark place and they should stay crisp. Make sure there are no bruised or damaged Apples among stored boxes.

Vegetable Gardens will be growing new crops for the cooler seasons. Leaf veg should not bolt so readily now and will not mind days getting shorter and cooler and root veg seeds will germinate well while the ground is still warm. My second sowing of Peas are up, Corn is picked and the Pumpkins have outgrown their space and just keep going. Onions can be lifted once leaves have bent over - don't bend or damage leaves before they are ready to bend naturally, if you want them to store and keep well. Once dug, lay them out in a warm place to fully ripen then store in a cool place. Cheers Linda.

Let's talk About the Importance of Handwashing

Keeping hands clean is one of the most important steps to avoid getting sick and spreading germs to others. Many diseases and conditions are spread by not washing hands with soap and clean, running water. Washing hands prevents illnesses and spread of infections to others, handwashing with soap removes germs from hands. Helping to prevent infections because people frequently touch their eyes, nose, and mouth without even realizing it. Germs can get into the body through the eyes, nose and mouth and make us sick. Germs from unwashed hands can get into foods and drinks while people prepare or consume them. Germs can multiply in some types of foods or drinks, under certain conditions, and make people sick. Germs from unwashed hands can be transferred to other objects, like handrails, table tops, or toys, and then transferred to another person's hands. Removing germs through handwashing therefore helps prevent diarrhea and respiratory infections and may even help prevent skin and eye infections. It's one of the basics we all need to teach our kids, and keep in mind day to day until it has become second nature. What is the right way to wash your hands? Follow these five steps below to wash your hands the right way every time. Wet your hands with clean, running water (warm or cold), turn off the tap, and apply soap. Lather your hands by rubbing them together with the soap. Be sure to lather the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails. Scrub your hands for at least 20 seconds. Rinse your hands well under clean, running water. Dry your hands using a clean towel or air dry them. To stop the spread of germs in your family, make regular hand washing a rule for everyone. It's especially important: before eating and cooking, after using the bathroom, after cleaning around the house, after touching animals, including family pets. Before and after visiting or taking care of any sick friends or relatives, after blowing one's nose, coughing, or sneezing, after being outside (playing, gardening, walking the dog, etc.) Sometimes water and soap are not available or in between hand wash you can use a hand sanitizer, they are gels that contain alcohol in order to kill the germs present on the skin. The alcohol works immediately and effectively in order to kill bacteria and most viruses. To use hand sanitizers effectively, place a small amount, the size of your thumbnail, on the palm of your hand and rub it over your entire hand, including in your nail beds. Hand sanitizers are convenient, portable, easy to use and not time consuming. But they have some limitations. Not all hand sanitizers are created equally. Check the bottle for active ingredients. The alcohol content may be in the form of ethyl alcohol, ethanol or isopropanol which are all acceptable forms of alcohol. Be certain that no matter which type of alcohol is listed, its concentration is between 60 and 95 per cent. Any alcohol content of less than 60 per cent isn't enough to be effective. Alcohol does not cut through grime, hand-washing with soap and water is advised as hand sanitizers are not cleaning agents and are not meant as a replacement for soap and water, but as a complementary habit. Sanitizers are most effective when used in conjunction with diligent hand-washing. The use of hand sanitizers is a habit that can help keep us all exposed to fewer germs, and therefore may decrease our chance of illness. *Whether you are on the playground, using someone else's computer or visiting a friend in the hospital, take the time to rub some on your hands. 1 egg lightly beaten - or 1 tsp no egg replacement in 2
Tlbsp water 1 cup soy milk
1 cup vegetable oil
1 1/2 cups self raising flours
1/2 cup plain flour
1 tsp baking soda
1 1/2 ground cinnamon
1 pear, cored and finely chopped
3/4 cup firmly packed brown sugar
3 tsp icing sugar

In separate bowl sift flours, baking soda and 1 tsp

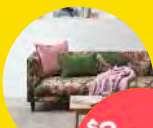

Keep the Heat in this Winter

Window furnishings are a fabulous way to keep your home warm. If you want drapes in time for winter you need to start looking now.

The quality of your lining is very important, not only to stop heat escaping but also to protect your fabric from the sun. Blackout lining is woven extremely tightly to stop the light from entering which in turn also blocks more cold air. Blackout lining is coated three times with thermal backing as opposed to only one coating on standard thermal lining. Single glazed homes would be wise to include an interlining called Bumf for additional protection.

Another idea for keeping the warmth in is to use a blackout honeycomb blind. These are slim line and minimalistic, fitting snugly inside the architrave. They are lined with silver foil to reflect the heat back into the room.

There is nothing more luscious than beautiful full length drapes. Most people don't realise what drapes can do for acoustics too by absorbing sound. In a new build, once the drapes have been installed the difference is really quite noticeable. It's not only thermal protection and privacy which drapes provide, it's also a chance to play with texture, pattern and colour in your interior scheme.

I believe that the drapes are the icing on the cake, as soon as we put up those drapes the room feels complete.

Bookarama Oamaru postponed

Our annual event is necessarily postponed due to Covid-19. The Rotary Club of Oamaru's annual Bookarama was scheduled to be held Friday May 22nd to Sunday May 24th this year. Due to the Covid-19 restrictions, the event and related book collections are being postponed.

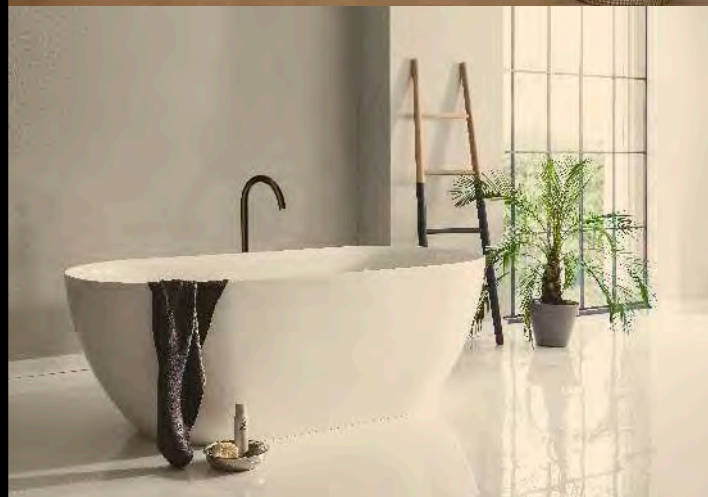
Bookarama Organiser, Jacquie Webby said, "We've been watching the situation along with everyone. We have to recognise that many of our volunteers are in older age groups and are therefore more at risk for the worst effects of Covid-19". Bookarama is traditionally a non-ticketed event and in the current climate tickets are essential in case contact tracing is required. Bookarama is also well-known for gathering a large crowd on opening morning. As viruses can live on different surfaces for an unknown number of hours, Rotary Oamaru recognises that the close proximity of people sharing the handling of many books makes the risk for cross contamination unacceptably high.

Jacquie Webby said, "With yesterday's request from the government that we cancel all events of more than 500 people, as well as the pressing need for social distancing, regular hand washing and protecting our older populations, continuing our plans for collections and holding the event as anticipated would be irresponsible."

The essential precursor to any Bookarama is the many weeks of donating, collecting and sorting of the thousands of books along with puzzles, games, DVDs and music. Jacquie Webby said, "We need about a ten-week lead-in. The call for donations was due to start this week and run for the next couple of months". President of the Rotary Club of Oamaru, Blair Middlemass said, "I do want to thank the team for all the behind-the-scenes work that got us to right up to the starting line of promoting Bookarama, this week. Thanks to their planning, when the time is right Bookarama will be ready to happen. We know it's a much-loved local event, a highlight of the year for many and it will return when it's appropriate to bring our community back together".

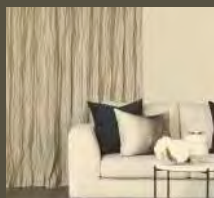

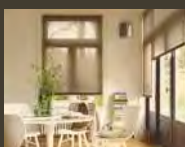
